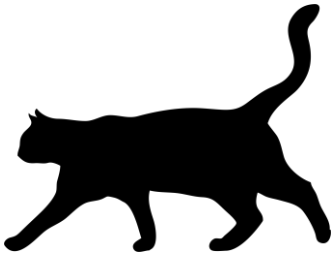
1. This is the house [Q : *Is that the house ?*]
This is the house that Jack built... that Jack built.



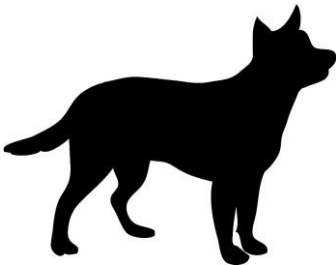
2. This is the malt [Q : *Is that the malt ?*]
